Open webinar: Introduction to REMIT (Monday 25 October, 10:00-12:00 CET)

This open and free webinar is the first step for newcomers to better understand REMIT and a gateway to further explore the integrity and transparency of EU wholesale energy markets. The webinar aims to introduce the concept of REMIT to researchers, journalists and all other interested public. It shall serve as a warm up prior to the main event.
